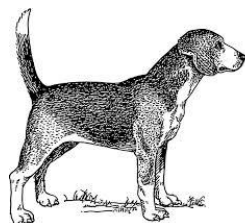

Rules:

1. Please read the complete general rules and the dog rules found in the [4-H Dog Division El Paso County Fair Contest Requirements](#). Go to the CSU Extension El Paso County 4-H Fair resource webpage to access the 4-H dog rules: <http://elpaso.extension.colostate.edu/el-paso-county-fair-resources/>
2. Please note: The El Paso County 4-H Dog Project follows the State Fair 4-H Dog Trial rules and classes for many of county-level events. Please refer to state fair guidelines for rule clarifications and scoring for all obedience classes.
3. **Fees:** Showmanship is free for all Dog 4-H exhibitors. Obedience, Rally, and Agility classes are **\$5.00** per exhibitor, per dog. Fair Entry payments are due to the CSU Extension Office by **Friday, June 30, 2017**.

Using Fair Entry:

1. Please first download or print the Fair Entry instructions and review the information found on the El Paso County 4-H Fair Resource page: <http://elpaso.extension.colostate.edu/el-paso-county-fair-resources/>
2. Go to <https://fairentry.com/> and click on “find your fair” to locate the 2017 El Paso County Fair.
3. The Fair Entry online system works best if you are using **Google Chrome** or **Mozilla Firefox** as your search engine. Users may experience errors when using older versions of Internet Explorer.
4. For families with multiple children - Be sure to register all entries for each exhibitor in the family before proceeding to the Payment section.
5. When you get to the “Review Your Entries” step it is suggested that you click on the “detail”

- button rather than the summary button to review all the classes you have selected.
6. Click the “Submit” button **ONLY** when you have reviewed and completed your entries. Entries are not final until they have been submitted.
7. Check your email inbox for a confirmation email with a list of your entries and instructions regarding fees. You will receive a second email when your entries have been approved by the CSU Extension Office. Please send in payment after you receive the second e-mail stating the entries have been approved.
8. If you experience a glitch with the Fair Entry online system or receive an error message, be sure to write down the error message and contact the CSU Extension El Paso County 4-H Office for assistance at **(719) 520-7698**.
9. Fair Entry will prompt you to “add an animal” when necessary to declare a specific dog for a class. The dog ID information already entered into 4HOnline back in April should be available for you to select from.

Helpful Hints:

1. Use this tool to select the classes the 4-H Dog Project member intends to exhibit/participate. Check off the classes and then have the tool handy when you log into the Fair Entry system to help the computer user remember to select all the appropriate 4-H dog project classes.
2. Be aware that Fair Entry lists divisions and classes in alphabetical order. This tool is designed to match the Fair Entry alphabetical listing.
3. **Showmanship Reminder** – each 4-H member is required to participate in Showmanship!
4. **Fair Eligibility** - Don’t forget that to be eligible for the El Paso County Fair, Dog 4-H Project members must compete in one 4-H “open show” that is prior to the County Fair. You can attend a 4-H Dog Show in a neighboring county or attend the **El Paso County 4-H Dog Open Show June 10 and 11**.

Dog: Canine Good Citizen (CGC) County Fair Display Board Exhibit

Review the complete rules and meet the participation requirements listed in the [4-H Dog Division El Paso County Fair Contest Requirements](#).

1. Submit by 2 PM on Tabletop Exhibit Day (Friday before County Fair) a tri-fold poster board that describes your activities/learning process in CGC.
2. Display boards (show boards) for fair must be tri-fold boards that measure 4' wide x 3' tall. They should be made of lightweight cardboard, but not thin poster board. Pre-cut boards are available at most craft and shopping centers. No part of your display may extend beyond these boundaries.

No Fees for photo entries

Rules:

1. Submit photo by 2 PM on Tabletop Exhibit Day (Friday before County Fair).
2. The subject of the photo must be your project dog. Except for Cloverbud entries.
3. 4-H members may only submit one photo for the 4-H Dog Photo Contest.
4. The 4-H exhibitor must take the photo.
5. Color or black & white photos will be accepted.
6. Any size up to 8" x 10" is acceptable.
7. The photo must be in a stand up frame.
8. The exhibitors name, age and club must be on the back of the frame.
9. Categories are: Cloverbud, Junior, Intermediate and Senior.
10. All participants receive a participation ribbon.

Class:**499. Puppy Class Showmanship**

(Non Regular class to meet showmanship requirements)

This class is for members of all ages. You can enter this class with puppies age 9 months or younger. If you have an of age dog you must also enter regular showmanship. This class is for young dogs getting their first taste of showmanship. Each handler and puppy will enter the ring individually. This is a PASS/FAIL class no scores are given. Handler should know basic showmanship procedures.

500. Junior Novice Showmanship

This class is for members who are 8 – 10 years old as of December 31 of the previous year, are in their 1st year of participation in the project, and have no prior experience with any other dog showing entity.

501. Junior Open Showmanship

This class is for members who are 8-10 years old as of December 31 of the previous year and have previous experience in showmanship.

502. Intermediate Novice Showmanship

This class is for members who are 11-13 years old as of December 31 of the previous year, are in their 1st year of participation in the project, and have no prior experience with any other dog showing entity.

503. Intermediate Open Showmanship

This class is for members who are 11-13 years old as of December 31 of the previous year and have previous experience in showmanship.

504. Intermediate Advanced Showmanship

This class is for members who are 11-13 years old as

of December 31 of the previous year and have previous experience in showmanship. Any member who has placed 1st through 10th at a previous State Dog Trial Intermediate Open Showmanship must enter Intermediate Advanced Showmanship

505. Senior Novice Showmanship

This class is for members who are 14-18 years old as of December 31 of the previous year, are in their 1st year of participation in the project, and have no prior experience with any other dog showing entity.

506. Senior Open Showmanship

This class is for members who are 14-18 years old as of December 31 of the previous year and have previous experience in showmanship.

52. Senior Advanced Showmanship

This class is for members who are 14-18 years of age as of December 31 of the previous year. Any member who has placed 1st through 10th at a previous State Dog Trial in Senior Open Showmanship must enter Senior Advanced Showmanship.
