Rules:

1. Please read the complete general rules and the swine rules found in the **[El Paso County 4-H Livestock Exhibit Requirements](http://elpaso.extension.colostate.edu/4-h-livestock-exhibit-requirements)**. Please go to the CSU Extension El Paso County 4-H Fair resource webpage to access the 4-H swine rules in the Livestock Exhibit Requirements Guide: <http://elpaso.extension.colostate.edu/4-h-member-and-volunteer-resources/> and scroll to the bottom of the page.
2. Maximum of two (2) market swine per exhibitor. In breeding classes, all exhibitors are limited to two entries per class.
3. **Fees:** Showmanship is free for all Swine 4-H exhibitors. Breeding swine classes are **\$5.00** per animal entry. Market swine classes are **\$10.00** per animal entry.
4. **Stalls:** Swine stalls are \$5.00 per stall (two animals per stall). All breeding swine must go home on Sunday and may not stay for the entire fair due to space constraints.
5. FairEntry payments are due to the CSU Extension Office by **Friday, June 29, 2018**.

Using FairEntry:

1. Please first download or print the FairEntry instructions and review the information found on the El Paso County 4-H Fair Resource page: <http://elpaso.extension.colostate.edu/4-h-member-and-volunteer-resources/> and scroll to the bottom of the page.
2. Go to <https://faireentry.com/> and click on “find your fair” to locate the 2018 El Paso County Fair.
3. The FairEntry online system works best if you are using **Google Chrome** or **Mozilla Firefox** as your search engine. Users may experience errors when using older versions of Internet Explorer.
4. For families with multiple children - Be sure to register all entries for each exhibitor in the family before proceeding to the Payment section.
5. When you get to the “Review Your Entries” step it is suggested that you click on the “detail” button rather than the summary button to review all the classes you have selected.
6. Click the “Submit” button **ONLY** when you have

- reviewed and completed your entries. Entries are not final until they have been submitted.
7. Check your email inbox for a confirmation email with a list of your entries and instructions regarding fees. You will receive a second email when your entries have been approved by the CSU Extension Office. Please send in payment after you receive the second e-mail stating the entries have been approved.
 8. If you experience a glitch with the FairEntry online system or receive an error message, be sure to write down the error message and contact the CSU Extension El Paso County 4-H Office for assistance at **(719) 520-7698**.
 9. FairEntry will prompt you to “add an animal” when necessary to declare a specific animal for a class. If you already entered animal ID information in 4HOnline it should be available for you to select from. Otherwise, you will need to “add an animal” and enter animal identification information into FairEntry. Have your animal records handy when using FairEntry so you can refer to your records.

Helpful Hints:

1. Use this tool to select the classes the 4-H swine project member intends to exhibit/participate. Check off the classes and then have the tool handy when you log into the FairEntry system to help the computer user remember to select all the appropriate 4-H sheep project classes.
2. Be aware that FairEntry lists divisions and classes in alphabetical order. This tool is designed to match the FairEntry alphabetical listing.
3. **Showmanship Reminder** – each 4-H member is required to participate in Showmanship! If a 4-H member plans to exhibit both breeding and market animals, plan to enter both the breeding and market showmanship classes.
4. **Fair Eligibility** - Don’t forget that to be eligible for the El Paso County Fair, you must be enrolled in the project you plan to exhibit.
5. Select the same class more than once for multiple swine entries of the same type/age.

Livestock: Swine Stalls (two animals per stall)

Consider the number of breeding swine animals the 4-H member plans to exhibit when determining the number of stalls needed. Breeding swine are replaced by market swine animals. Breeding swine will be stalled, shown, and released on Opening Saturday. Exhibitors have the option of leaving breeding swine in stalls until market swine begin arriving on Opening Sunday. If the exhibitor does not have market swine, then they must take their breeding animal's home and have their stalls cleaned prior to market animals being brought in.

Swine Stall 1 - (two animals per stall) \$5

Swine Stall 2 - if more than two animals (two animals per stall) \$5

Swine Stall 3 - if more than four animals (two animals per stall)
