I'm sure there are lots of questions about Sale Day tomorrow. For now, please refer to the Sale Day Information sheet you received in your Sale Packet. Watch for more updates as the day goes on. The most important thing about tomorrow you need to know is the stalling times, which are as follows:

Entry to the fairgrounds and barns will be facilitated through the South Parking Lot and Gates:

- Sheep and Swine will stall between 7:30 am and 8:30 am
- Poultry will stall between 8:30 am and 9:30 am
- Beef and Goats will stall between 9 am and 10 am

4-H Exhibit/Tabletop Day Fair Awards Clarification:

El Paso County uses the Danish System for 4-H Exhibit awards at fair. The Danish system is a method for rating work completed but is not competitive with other peers in the same category. This means one 4-Her's work is not compared to another 4-H project. The evaluation is made on a specific standard.

- A blue ribbon signifies excellent work (90-100)
- A red ribbon signifies very good work (80-89)
- A white ribbon signifies quality work that can be improved with few changes (70-79)

The purpose of this system is to enhance the individual learning process so youth understand what could be improved upon.... making the best better!

It has come to our attention, the ribbons given at the 4-H Exhibit/Tabletop show this year indicated a placing, such as 1st, 2nd, or 3rd. We apologize for the confusion. If your child received a blue, red, or white ribbon, it indicates their quality of work, and not peer competition. Only those receiving a "champion" ribbon will be advancing to state fair.
