3. **Fees: \$5** class fee per exhibitor, per dog; **\$1** per animal. **No fee** for Showmanship; Canine Good Citizen and Dog Photo Contest which is open to Cloverbuds
4. **Registration for the classes listed in this guide will open May 24-June 11 via the FairEntry.com website.**

2. **Families with more than one exhibitor: please be sure to register all 4-Hers/FFA members on the same invoice before submitting fair registration.**
3. Have your animal records handy when using FairEntry so you can refer to your records if needed when adding animals.
4. If you experience a glitch with the FairEntry online system or receive an error message, be sure to write down the error message and contact the CSU Extension, El Paso County 4-H Office.

How to use this tool:

1. Use this tool to select classes to enter the Dog Trails Contest at the El Paso County Fair. Check the classes your member wants to enter and then have this tool handy when you log into FairEntry to register.
2. This class list is designed to match the way classes are laid out in Fair Entry.
3. **Showmanship Reminder – each 4-H member is required to participate in Showmanship**
4. **Fair Eligibility** - Don't forget that to be eligible for the El Paso County Fair, you must be enrolled in the project you plan to exhibit.

Division: Canine Good Citizen (CGC) County Fair Display Board Exhibit

- Review the complete rules and meet the participation requirements listed in the 4-H Dog Division El Paso County Fair Contest Requirements.
- Deliver your board to the County Fairgrounds (Whittmore Building) on Friday June 10th for Tabletop Exhibit Day
- The display should be a tri-fold poster board that describes your activities/learning process in CGC.
- Display boards (show boards) for fair must be tri-fold boards that measure 4’ wide x 3’ tall. They should be made of lightweight cardboard, but not thin poster board. Pre-cut boards are available at most craft and shopping centers. No part of your display may extend beyond these boundaries.

Division: Dog Photo Contest

Rules:

- Deliver your photo to the County Fairgrounds (Whittmore Building) on **Friday July 9th** for Tabletop Exhibit Day.
- The subject of the photo must be your project dog.
- 4-H members may only submit one photo for the 4-H Dog Photo Contest.
- The 4-H exhibitor must take the photo.
- Color or black & white photos will be accepted.
- Any size up to 8" x 10" is acceptable.
- The photo must be in a stand up frame.
- The exhibitors name, age and club must be on the back of the frame.
- All participants receive a participation ribbon.
