

- 2. Families with more than one exhibitor: please be sure to register all 4-Hers/FFA members on the same invoice before submitting fair registration.
- 3. Have your animal records handy when using FairEntry so you can refer to your records if needed when adding animals.
- 4. If you experience a glitch with the FairEntry online system or receive an error message, be sure to write down the error message and contact the CSU Extension, El Paso County 4-H Office.

How to use this tool:

- Use this tool to select classes to enter the Goat Show at the El Paso County Fair. Check the classes your member wants to enter and then have this tool handy when you log into FairEntry to register.
- 2. This class list is designed to match the way classes are laid out in Fair Entry.
- 3. Showmanship Reminder each 4-H member is required to participate in Showmanship
