Rules:

1. 2. Contact the **Goat Superintendent** with all questions about this show including stalling, what classes to enter and all other requirements for participation
3. **Fees:** \$10.00 per market animal; \$5.00 per animal registered in all other classes.
4. **Stalling:** Details regarding stalling and fees will be released at a later date.
5. **Registration for the classes listed in this guide will open May 25 –June 11 via the FairEntry.com website.**

2. **Families with more than one exhibitor: please be sure to register all 4-Hers/FFA members on the same invoice before submitting fair registration.**
3. Have your animal records handy when using FairEntry so you can refer to your records if needed when adding animals.
4. If you experience a glitch with the FairEntry online system or receive an error message, be sure to write down the error message and contact the CSU Extension, El Paso County 4-H Office.

How to use this tool:

1. Use this tool to select classes to enter the Goat Show at the El Paso County Fair. Check the classes your member wants to enter and then have this tool handy when you log into FairEntry to register.
2. This class list is designed to match the way classes are laid out in Fair Entry.
3. **Showmanship Reminder – each 4-H member is required to participate in Showmanship**

Fair Eligibility - Don't forget that to be eligible for the El Paso County Fair, you must be enrolled in the project you plan to exhibit

***Swiss is defined as Saanen, Alpine, Toggenburg and Oberhasli, Nigerian and Sable**

***Crossbred goats with Nubian Type Ears will be placed in Nubian classes as well as LaManchas**

- 4A:** Senior Doe-**Nubian**: Milking Yearling-Born on or after July 14 previous year
- 4B:** Senior Doe-**Nubian**: 2 Year and Under 3
- 4C:** Senior Doe-**Nubian**: 3 Year and Under 5
- 4D:** Senior Doe-**Nubian**: 5 Year and Older
- 5A:** Senior Doe-**Swiss***: Milking Yearling-Born on or after July 14 previous year
- 5B:** Senior Doe-**Swiss***: 2 Year and Under 3

- 5C:** Senior Doe-**Swiss***: 3 Year and Under 5
- 5D:** Senior Doe-**Swiss***: 5 Year and Older
- 6A:** Junior Doe-**Nubian**: Junior Kid-Born on or after May 1 of the current year (NO males)
- 6B:** Junior Doe-**Nubian**: Intermediate Kid-Born on or after April 1 of the current year
- 6C:** Junior Doe-**Nubian**: Senior Kid-Born January 1-March 31 of the current year
- 6D:** Junior Doe-**Nubian**: Non Milking Yearling-Under two years old as of the date of the show
- 7A:** Junior Doe-**Swiss***: Junior Kid-Born on or after May 1 of the current year (NO males)
- 7B:** Junior Doe-**Swiss***: Intermediate Kid-Born on or after April 1 of the current year
- 7C:** Junior Doe-**Swiss***: Senior Kid-Born January 1-March 31 of the current year
- 7D:** Junior Doe-**Swiss***: Non Milking Yearling-Under two years old as of the date of the show
- 8A:** Junior Wether: Under a year old as of the date of the show
- 8B:** Senior Wether: Over a year old as of the date of the show
