



Llama/Alpaca Achievement Awards



1. The Triumph Award

- **Summary:** A 4-H member in the Llama/Alpaca project that has overcome obstacles to improve themselves and their animal. They show triumph and perseverance through their challenges
- **Criteria:**
 - A short-written description with the child and/or parent explaining the triumph the youth has faced this year in 4-H
 - The document must be submitted by September 1 to the livestock extension agent
 - A committee will be formed that includes three organizational club leader(s) and/or outside project leaders to decide the winner of the award

2. The Most Improved Award

- **Summary:** The 4-H member in the Llama/Alpaca Project that has shown the most growth in project during the year
- **Criteria:**
 - Nominated by a club or project leader by submitting the youth's name and short description to the livestock extension agent by September 1
 - A committee will be formed that includes three organizational club leader(s) and/or outside project leaders to decide the winner of the award

3. The Service Award

- **Summary:** A 4-H member in the Llama/Alpaca project that has done the most community service hours
 - Community service projects should be things that benefit others and outside groups not our own program.
 - When selecting a community service project for your club try and select one that is not self-serving but rather one that benefits the community or a segment of the community/county.
- **Criteria:** The 4-H member in the Llama/Alpaca project who has done the most community service hours. **Please see attached form.** Must be emailed to Emily.Tobler@colostate.edu by September 1.

4. The High Achiever Award

- **Summary:** The 4-H Member in the Llama/Alpaca project that has attended the most project meetings, project clinics, project events, and project practices
- **Criteria:** The 4-H member in the Llama/Alpaca project that has the most participation in the project. **Please see attached form.** Must be emailed to Emily.Tobler@colostate.edu by September 1.
