



4-H Online 2.0 New Volunteer Registration Guide

New Enrollment

Join over 11,000 adults committed to youth across Colorado by joining the Colorado 4-H youth development program! How do you become a 4-H leader? **Enroll using the instructions below and you will be contacted the El Paso County, CSU Extension Office with additional instructions.**

The safety of 4-H members is paramount. You will be asked to fill out an application and undergo a national background and motor vehicle check in order to become a volunteer.

Be sure to contact your local county extension office prior to beginning your online enrollment.

Log into co.4honline.com.

1) Click on “Don’t have an account?”

- a) Select the state of Colorado and then click on “Colorado 4-H Youth Development”
- b) Select “El Paso” when choosing a county and complete the required information to create your account. When you are done, click ‘Create Account’.
- c) Create your password using the parameters below:
 - 1. Must be at least 10 characters long and contain a capital, lowercase and a number
 - 2. **Please ignore any instructions that tell you to include a special character**
 - 3. (for example: _!, \$, #, @, ?)

Helpful hints: Look for the buttons!

Throughout the enrollment process, look for the **Blue** buttons to proceed, and ultimately, the **Green** button to ‘submit’.

- 1) Once logged in you will be prompted to enter your address and then begin enrollment
- 2) You will then be taken to a screen titled ‘Add Member’, select **4-H** and then click **Next** at the bottom of the screen completing the required information and then moving to the next screen
- 3) Once your contact information is complete, click on **I want to join as a new or returning volunteer**
- 4) When you see “I’m confirming I want to enroll in 4-H as a Volunteer,” click “**Enroll.**”

5) Select **Volunteer Type(s): Activity Volunteer, Program Volunteer** and **Coach** are not currently being utilized, please don't select any roles under these categories. Only the two categories below are being utilized:

- a) **Club Volunteer**
- b) **Project Volunteer**

6) **Select Clubs**

- a) If you do not currently belong to a club, find El Paso County Volunteers and click **"Add."**
- b) If you do belong to a club, find that club and click **"Add."**
- c) Click **"Next."**

7) **Select Projects**

- a) This will only appear if you selected the Project volunteer type.
- b) Select whether you work on this project (or would like to) at the county or club level.
- c) Select the project and click **"Add."**
- d) Click **"Next"** when finished adding projects.

8) **About You**

- a) Click **"Show Questions."**
- b) Review data that is carried over and fill in any blank required fields.
- c) Click **"Next"** when done.

9) Review **Consents**.

- a) Type your full name and click **"Agree."**
- b) Click **"Next."**

10) Click **"Submit,"** then **"Confirm."**

- a) You will receive an email confirmation that your enrollment has been submitted.

11) **Click "Show Screening" – REQUIRED to enroll**

- a) Complete all required fields
 - i) the references entered will be contacted as part of the required volunteer background screening
- b) Enter N/A under middle name if you don't have one
- c) Scroll to the bottom of the page and sign and agree with the statement.
Background checks will be completed on NEW volunteers or volunteers with a non-active status greater 12
