

FairEntry Opens May 31



Pre-entry for the El Paso County Fair will open on May 31st and is required for all 4-H General, 4-H Consumer Science, 4-H Cloverbud and 4-H Animal exhibits. All exhibits/animals must be pre-entered into the online FairEntry system. 4-H families will use their "4honline.com" username and password to log into the FairEntry system. FFA families should contact the El Paso County Extension Office to be provided a username and password.

Exhibits must be entered by Monday June 13, 2022. A late fee of \$25.00 per exhibitor will be assessed for entries received between June 13-15, 2022. After June 15, 2022, absolutely no entries will be accepted.

Once registration is complete and submitted by the family for all members participating in county fair, it will be sent to CSU Extension 4-H staff for approval. Once approved, payment instructions will be sent via email. Payment SHOULD NOT be sent until all classes are approved by CSU Extension staff. Payment must be received by 4:30 p.m. Friday June 17, 2022. It is the member's responsibility to check with the Extension Office to make sure the entry and payment were completed by the deadline.

What's the Why Behind Talking to Buyers?

Why is it so important to talk to buyers before fair? Businesses do not come to fair to buy a \$5000 steer, they come to support the youth who raised that steer and invest in their future. Building that relationship with a buyer can mean a difference in the amount of support they are willing to offer. This doesn't mean you need to go out and talk to 60 different people, pick a few that you can build a good relationship with. Call and make an appointment to speak with them. Let them know what you are doing with your animal, how you are planning to market your project and build on it year over year. What are your plans for the future? How will you use the sale proceeds to further your plans? Do not ask them to "buy your animal", instead encourage them to come to the sale and support the program and the youth in the sale. It is already implied that you would like them to support you and your project because you are there speaking with them, without sounding like your asking for money. As you grow through your 4H career these same buyers will get to know you and grow their support in you. Be sure to make some casual contact throughout the year with them. Send a Christmas card, a note to remind them that you'll be reaching out soon, a personal visit, a postcard reminder about the sale day. At fair, let them know what round you're in and how your project finished. Thank them for coming out to support the Jr. Livestock Sale and wish them luck in the auction.

Open Pregnancy Verification for Market Heifers

All market heifers must be accompanied by a certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian verifying the heifer is pregnancy tested OPEN within 30 days of the El Paso County Fair.

Market Beef Rate of Gain Contest



The Rate of Gain contest for youth enrolled in market beef will have a re-weigh date on **May 7th from 7:00-8:00 AM.** If you miss the time frame for the re-weigh, you will not be eligible for the contest--no exceptions.

Animals must be led across the parking lot and scale, as there will not be any alleyways to help guide.

Attending the re-weigh date listed above is one of the required steps to be eligible for this contest. If you have any more questions, the entire contest is outlined in the premium book.

Animals that required to have health certifications for County Fair issued within 14 days prior to the stalling at fair are:

- Llama/Alpacas
- Miniature Horses
- All Livestock

Each animal must be individually identified on the certificate.

Affordable Health Certificates Offered on July 9

Every year, the Livestock Advisory Committee offers 4-H members the opportunity to haul their animals to a specific location to receive a health certificate for county fair animals. This will take place on Saturday July 2, 2022 at Latigo Trails Equestrian Center (13710 Hallelujah Trail)

Health Certificates cost \$5/animal and CASH ONLY (exact cash preferred)

We will be set up by the outside roping/rodeo arena and have volunteers help directing the flow of traffic (same location as previous years). If you would like to obtain a health certificate on this day you will need to fill out the survey link below by Friday June 17, 2022 at 12 PM. We will then assign five-minute time slots to 4-H families. Look for an email that contains the schedule and updates about procedures.

All livestock MUST be accompanied by an official Health Certificate issued within 14 days prior to the start of fair. Each animal must be individually identified on the certificate. At fair you will need to make sure you have a copy of your health certificate for every day you enter the fairgrounds with animals




