- 2. Families with more than one exhibitor: please be sure to register all 4-Hers/FFA members on the same invoice before submitting fair registration.
- Have your animal records handy when using FairEntry so you can refer to your records if needed when adding animals.
- 4. If you experience a glitch with the FairEntry online system or receive an error message, be sure to write down the error message and contact the CSU Extension, El Paso County 4-H Office.
