Emily gave a report from the extension office. Extension Report- 4/23- County Contest. 4/25 Sheep and goat clinic. 4/28 Swine tag pickup. April 30<sup>th</sup> is Horse Bowl. May 1<sup>st</sup> is MQA and small animal boot camp. May 7<sup>th</sup> is beef reweigh and swine DNA drop off. May 20-22 is Cattle clinic. May 22<sup>nd</sup> is Ranch riding clinic; registration will be required. Master showman June 11<sup>th</sup>. Miniature Horse show June 25<sup>th</sup> and Trail Blazers show June 26<sup>th</sup>. Health Certifications will be done on July 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Randi gave the miniature horse report. She reported on the Easter Egg Hunt. \$234 was made on the raffle. Next year we will include more species. Randi reported that materials for jumps for the mini's needs to be purchased. Maggie motioned that a check be written to Randi to cover the cost of jumps for the minis. The motion was seconded by Staci and it passed.

Fund-raising committee reported being just \$1000 short for awards. Mercedes has a list of prices for awards. Mercedes is going to move forward with ordering. Will present invoice in May
