## Rules:

2. Contact the **Rabbit Superintendent** with all questions about this show, what classes to enter and all other requirements for participation
3. **Fees:** \$5 per exhibitor; \$1 per animal entered into breed classes; \$1 per Market Show Class entries (including trios). **No fee** for Showmanship, Premier Exhibitor, or Supreme Market Rabbit
4. **Registration for the classes listed in this guide will open May 31– June 13 via the FairEntry.com website.**

## Using FairEntry:

1. Please download and use the [Fair Registration Instructions](#) to register for these classes in FairEntry. Find it on the CSU Extension, El Paso County website under 4-H, Member resources, Fair tab.
2. **FFA Families:** Please contact the CSU Extension, El Paso County 4-H office to be provided a log-in for FairEntry.
3. **Families with more than one exhibitor: please be sure to register all 4-Hers/FFA members before submitting fair registration.**
4. Have your animal records handy when using FairEntry so you can refer to your records if needed when adding animals.
5. If you experience a glitch with the FairEntry online system or receive an error message, be sure to write down the error message and contact the CSU Extension, El Paso County 4-H Office.

## How to use this tool:

1. Use this tool to select classes to enter the Rabbit Show at the El Paso County Fair. Check the classes your member wants to enter and then have this tool handy when you log into FairEntry to register.
2. This class list is designed to match the way classes are laid out in Fair Entry.
3. **Showmanship Reminder – each 4-H member is required to participate in Showmanship**
4. **Fair Eligibility** - Don't forget that to be eligible for the El Paso County Fair, you must be enrolled in the project you plan to exhibit.

## Department: Small Animal-Rabbits

### Division: **REQUIRED**— Showmanship

- 1:** Rabbit Showmanship –Senior
- 2:** Rabbit Showmanship-Intermediate
- 3:** Rabbit Showmanship-Junior
- 4:** Novice (This class is optional for first year members at any age, does not compete for a belt buckle)

### Division: Breeds maturing under nine pounds

- 1:** Senior Buck Six Months of Age or Older
- 2:** Senior Doe Six Months of Age or Older
- 3:** Junior Buck Under Six Months of Age
- 4:** Junior Doe Under Six Months of Age

### Division: Breeds maturing at nine pounds or more

- 5:** Senior Buck Eight Months of Age or Older
- 6:** Senior Doe Eight Months of Age or Older
- 7:** Intermediate Buck Six months to Eight Months
- 8:** Intermediate Doe Six months to Eight Months
- 9:** Junior Buck Under Six Months of Age
- 10:** Junior Doe Under Six Months of Age

### Division: Pet Class (Mixed Breeds)

- 11A:** Pet Class-Buck
- 11B:** Pet Class-Doe

### Division: Market Rabbits

- 12:** Single Fryer (1 rabbit)
- 13:** Meat Pen Class (3 rabbits)

### Division: Premier Rabbit Exhibitor

- Premier Exhibitor Rabbit- All ages

### Division: Supreme Market Rabbit

- Supreme Market Rabbit (All ages)
