Lisa Anderson purchased supplies for jumps for the total of \$93.32. A motion was made by the member from Golden

Prairie 4-H club to reimburse Lisa for the cost of the jumps. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously with a check being cut from general funds.

Emily gave a report from the extension office. Dress and Bits educational clinic after the meeting. The 24th the sale committee will have a meeting in the Swink building. Fair entry opens May 31st and closes June 13th. June 4-5 Next Level livestock clinic. Country Style Show is June 4th. June 5th is horse judging and Hippology. Superintendent meeting at the Extension office on June 6th at 6:30. Master Showman Clinic on June 11th. Emily will be gone June 17th- June 27th. Miniature horse and horse test is June 29th. Patterns will also be handed out then. June 30th and July 6th there will be training for announcing at fair. Sign up is in the newsletter. Health Certificates are July 2nd at latigo. Miniature horses will need health certificates. July 9th is fair clean up. Bob has not needed our help at Latigo. June 17th is a painting and pizza party at Latigo. County fair horse show is July 11th-12th. Fair is 16th-24th of July. July 22nd 8am is the Champion of Champion. Master showman will start at 9 am.

Randi gave the miniature horse report. She reported on the first miniature horse show. It was a great success. We even had attendees from other counties. 4-Bits hosted and had a concession.

Fund-raising committee reported that awards have been ordered.

Unfinished Business

Mercedes reached out to the Ackers paint drop off for donations for paint for the poles. Kayla reported on the sign for fair. \$550 for a 6x12. Autumn mentioned using a smaller valance banner with stall curtains. Kayla will find prices for a 6x2 banner. Mercedes reported that poles have been ordered and need to be picked. Flower boxes still need to be made by Randi, but she reported that the bridge is done. Trailblazers is hosting a Ranch clinic and show June 29th. There will be a written test. Ranch show is \$5 a class or \$25 for whole day. Located at KCRC.

New Business

Randi reported that the HAC show box is needing supplies. Safety pins, batteries, and pencils. Emily said she would get those supplies to us. We are needing volunteers/announcers for fair. It was mentioned to check with Maddison Ferguson. Emily would like another volunteer to serve. We need to be looking to recruit more volunteers to join HAC. Mercedes reported on the T-shirts for fair. There will be two designs for people to choose from. Kids will get one design.

Master Showman Clinic is June 11th. Large animal master showman will have horses for the kids to practice on. Autumn is going to bring two.

Premium money- Because horse fair is before fair, we need to have HAC pay for premiums and then get reimbursed from the fair premium money. Kayla motioned to have HAC pay the money for the premiums and get reimbursed. Autumn seconded and the motioned passed.

Lisa Anderson would like to next year plan an overnight horse camp for horses and kids. This would be 2 days, 1 night. English/western. We need to pick a date for the fairgrounds as we can always cancel. This could also be a fundraiser. We could also include the mini horse and the horseless horse.
