 - Helping clean-up, set-up and take down facilities.
 - Assist with tag-ins and clinics leading up to fair
 - Assist during load-in and load-out
 - Assist with ultra-sounding, master showman, and judging contest
 - Attend announcing clinic
 - Attend superintendent and/or office livestock meetings.
 - Serving as ring/gate steward
 - Distributing ribbons and other awards
 - Help the youth be successful at county fair and with their project
2. Be available and willing to work during fair time.
