Fair Entry Opens May 30 (Registration Guide Updated)

Entry for the El Paso County Fair will opens on May 30th and is required for all 4-H General, 4-H Consumer Science, 4-H Cloverbud, and 4-H Animal projects who would like to exhibit at the 2023 County Fair. All exhibits/animals <u>MUST</u> be entered into the online FairEntry system. 4-H families will use their "4honline.com" username and password to log into the FairEntry system.

Exhibits must be entered by Friday June 9, 2023. A late fee of \$35.00 per family will be assessed for entries received between June 10-13, 2023. **After June 13, 2023, absolutely no entries will be accepted.**

Once registration is complete and submitted by the family for all members participating in county fair, it will be reviewed by CSU Extension 4-H staff for approval. Once approved, payment instructions will be sent via email. Payment **SHOULD NOT** be sent until all classes are approved by CSU Extension staff.

Payment must be received by 4:30 p.m. Thursday June 15, 2023. It is the member's responsibility to check with the Extension Office to make sure the entry and payment were completed by the deadline.


Market Beef Re-Weigh for Rate of Grain Contest

Sheep Fitting and Showing Clinic

On May 31st at 7:00 PM at the El Paso County Fairgrounds the Mauck family, from Douglas County, will be doing a sheep Fitting (shearing and show day prep). You can bring your animals to get some instruction and practice. They are a family who has learned a lot through 4-H. They discovered 4-H back in 2011 and started with general projects. Two years later they purchased their very first show lamb. This was their beginning experience with livestock. With no previous knowledge of the agricultural world, they soaked up everything we could learn. With some great mentors, a hunger to get better, and lots and lots of work, they slowly began to experience some success in the show world. Ten years later, they have been blessed to have had years of success at the Douglas County Fair. They had the privilege of showing the heavy weight champion goat at the 2021 Colorado State Fair. In 2022 they had the honor of exhibiting the medium weight champion market lamb, the reserve heavy weight champion market lamb, and the reserve champion breeding ewe at the Colorado State Fair. They have also had the reserve champion Duroc pig and the heavy weight champion Duroc pig at the Colorado State Fair. They said "every year we strive to learn more, to improve, and to get better as individuals and as a family." They are excited to come share what they have learned with us.

Health Certifications for County Fair

Every year, the Livestock Advisory Committee offers 4-H members the opportunity to haul their animals to a specific location to receive a health certificate for county fair animals. This will take place on Saturday July 8, 2023 at Latigo Trails Equestrian Center (13710 Hallelujah Trail)

Health Certificates cost \$5 per animal and CASH ONLY (exact cash preferred)

We will be set up by the outside roping/rodeo arena and have volunteers help directing the flow of traffic (same location as previous years). If you would like to obtain a health certificate on this day you will need to show up from 8:00-11:00 AM. There is no sign-up or registration. It is first come, first serve.

Animals are **required to have health certifications for County Fair issued within 14 days prior** to the start of county fair.

Each animal must be individually identified on the certificate.

All livestock **MUST** be accompanied by an official Health Certificate issued within 14 days prior to the start of county fair. At fair, you will need to make sure you have a copy of your health certificate for every day you enter the fairgrounds with animals.

We will not be differentiating between species so bring goats and/or sheep based on your last name.

Family has youth in the swine project (8:30-9:00 AM)

Last name beginning with M through Z (9:00-10:00 AM)

Last name beginning with A through L (10:00-11:00 AM)

Expectations:

- · Please be on time!
- · We believe in giving priority to those scheduled in their slot so we will not allow families who are late or miss their time slot to cut in front of others
- If our team is running behind, please be patient as we are working with live animals, technology, and a new process so sometimes it does not go as
 planned or expected.
- Only CASH will be accepted the day of tag in (read below for details on price breakouts)
- · State Fair Nominations will only be accepted the day of tag in, no exceptions

Things to know before coming:

- 1. You must bring your animal with a halter already on before it will be unloaded, or it will not be weighed. The idea is to work with them ahead of time
- 2. If your animals are sick or show signs of sore mouth and/or fungus please email Emily.Green@colostate.edu and we will have you go across the scale and tag in at the end.
- 3. Market ewes and market does MUST be scrapies tagged before tag-in. Please reach out to Emily.Green@colostate.edu if you have any questions.
- 4. Must Park in the South Parking Lot and stay off the concrete in the Owens Livestock Arena. Will walk animals to the scale from the North Arena Door.
- 5. Tag-in is the only time State Fair Nominations will be taken and will cost \$3 to nominate per animal (cash only)
 - o Remember all 4-H and FFA exhibitors must have their **premise ID#** on their nomination cards to be accepted for State Fair. This is a State Fair Policy NOT a requirement to participate in the local 4-H program. This information should be completed on ALL cards at the time of tag-in.
 - o You will need to apply for your premise ID number well in advance of tag in so they have time to assign you one. Please do so 3-4 weeks before you need it. Please call 303-869-9000 to get your ID or visit the website at https://ag.colorado.gov/animals/colorado-location-identification-lid-registration-premises.
- 6. Retinal scans at tag-in are \$3.00 per animal due at tag in (CASH ONLY). The first 6 ear tags free, \$1.00 per tag over six. Only cash will be accepted. Fees are due on the date of tag in.
- 7. If the weather is bad, please understand we will need to block off a different weekend.

REMEMBER: All animals must be castrated prior to being weighed and tagged in as a 4-H Market project. Castration must be done prior to arriving at the fairgrounds (Not the day of tag in) and healed as much as possible.



Important Notes—

The <u>Calhan Fire District</u> will be providing a brush truck for both launch events. If they leave, and there is a fire ban, we will need to cease launching.

<u>EAT BREAKFAST!</u> Since both events will be conducted earlier in the year, extreme heat may not be a problem. But we did have one child that suffered a seizure due to lack of food and water, and the high temperatures that year. This was the first time the child had a seizure. Fortunately, it happened during the fair, paramedics were there, and all turned out well. But we DO NOT want to see this happen again due to lack of sustenance and water.

<u>Bad Weather.</u> If there is a low ceiling where we would lose sight of the rockets, we will continue to conduct the program inside the Whittemore building. So, come rain, snow, low clouds or—

praise to be—sunny weather, we will conduct both events on the days and times as scheduled—barring blizzards and tornados!

<u>Remember!</u> You are not required to launch your 'Exhibit' rocket. But it is your choice to do so, if you wish to earn credit on it for your project e-records. If you launch your exhibit rocket and it gets damaged, you will have plenty of time prior to fair to repair it.

NOTE: You are <u>not allowed</u> to fly your Exhibit rocket for either the county fair or state fair Rocket Fly Day Contest; but, you can for your project work—if desired!

<u>Special Tip</u>: If you wish to launch your exhibit rocket, do so prior to painting it. It is easier to make any repairs after launching; then, finish with paint and decals for a nice show rocket and a good story!






