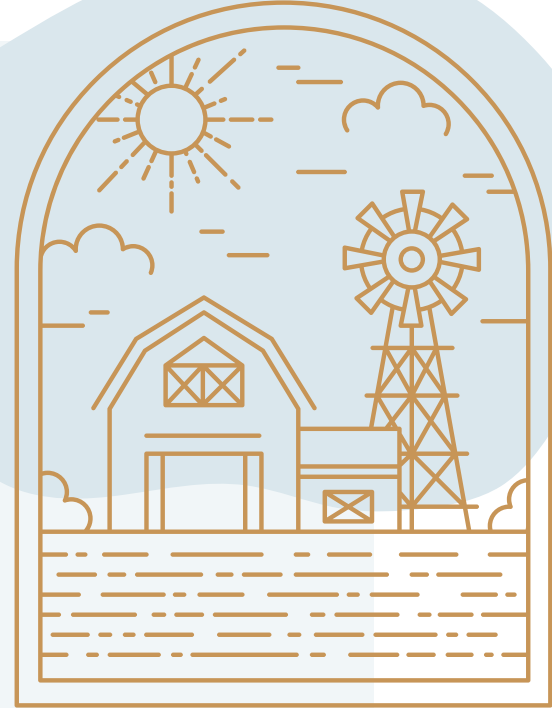

PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

STEM Lesson 1- Engineer It!, Participants will gain an understanding of what Engineers do and how different materials can be shaped to provide increased strength and stability!

Living necklace: Students will learn about a plant seed's needs in order to germinate and grow through creating their very own living necklace!

Rumen Exploration- Campers will learn hands on about the parts of the ruminant digestive track and their functions.

Source Relay: This fast-moving relay race teaches students that before any product leaves a factory, or enters a store, it begins as a resource or product of the natural world – most likely agriculture. Students will work in teams and run a relay race where they have to quickly make decisions.

Build a Brand: Students will learn about the purpose and history of branding, how to "call" a brand, and create one of their very own that will be registered in the official CAM's Ag Academy Brand registry.

STEM Lesson 2- Sounds of Science, campers will gain an understanding of how sound is produced, travels and perceived.
