New Business:

 - o Agricultural mats would need to be filled with bleach water
 - Use orange fencing to direct public traffic through the barn
 - Using weed sprayers to spray bleach solution
 - Requesting \$650 for biosecurity this year (biosecurity mats \$487.90, rug stakes \$15.99, bleach \$90, S/H \$29.95)
 - Motion to budget \$650 for Biosecurity mats, Rachel motioned to approve the use of \$650 for biosecurity for poultry this year for fair, Gerty second, Approved.
