# 4-H Online 2.0 Animal Entry Checklist

## Pygmy Goat Project

*\*Note: For 4-H Members 8 and above*

**NOTE: Pygmy Goat IDs must be entered before May 1.**

Listed below is the information and/or documents that are **required** for each Pygmy Goat ID

- Animal's tattoo or microchip #
- Animal's name
- Animal's birthdate
- Description of Animal's colors/markings
- Scrapie Flock ID (Only if Animal is NOT registered)
- Animal's Gender
- 1 image of the Animal showing colors/markings must be uploaded
- Registration papers or photo of scrapie tag must be uploaded
  - Please note that if the Animal is registered, registration papers may be uploaded in place of the scrapies, if the animal is NOT registered, a scrapies tag must be uploaded
