## Breeding Swine Project

\*Note: For 4-H Members 8 and above

## NOTE: Breeding Swine IDs must be entered before May 1.

Listed below is the information and/or documents that are required for each Breeding Swine ID

- Animal's tag number, if no tag number, enter '000'
- Animal's birthdate
- Enter ear notch for both Right and Left ear
- Animal's gender
- One profile photo of the Animal must be uploaded
- Image of Left ear of the Swine, must be able to read ear notch (take photo from behind the ear)
- Image of Right ear of the Swine, must be able to read ear notch (take photo from behind the ear)
- ONE of the following
  - Bill of Sale
  - Lease Agreement
  - Youth Livestock Ownership Affidavit
