Accommodations Form

Hello 4-H Families!

As a reminder to all., El Paso County 4-H and Colorado 4-H firmly believe that all 4-H members should be able to participate in 4-H Events and Activities with their peers successfully. This includes providing reasonable accommodation requests made on behalf of 4-H members. In an effort to streamline accommodation requests, El Paso County 4-H has developed a fillable form that can be accessed via the 4-H Website. This form should be used to request accommodations for each 4-H Event that accommodations may be required.

Colorado 4-H recognizes that accommodations may be requested orally and in person, up to the date of the event. However, the timing and manner of a request potentially reduces the county extension's ability to determine reasonable accommodation. Because it can take time to plan for some accommodations, El Paso County 4-H requests that the form be submitted no later than 14 days prior to the event or activity. Submitting a request for accommodation on shorter notice may reduce or limit county extension's ability to implement the accommodations. Please note that the accommodation may not be the one proposed by the participant.

Reminder of Animal Care and Housing Guidelines

All 4-H animal project members and their parents must complete and sign the Animal Care and Housing form in 4HOnline and submit a hard copy to their club leader. Club leaders then submit these forms to the El Paso County CSU Extension Office.

All youth must have care and custody of their animal at their home on record (which is indicated on the Care and Housing Form) with the CSU Extension Office throughout the project. If this changes then they must update their Animal Care & Housing Form on file with the CSU Extension Office as soon as the animal is at another location. Temporary housing should not exceed 72 hours without notifying the Extension Office. Livestock animals must be housed within county lines. Unless they reside outside the county but have county membership then the animals can reside at their residence. Anything beyond that needs to have prior approval from the Extension Office.

Please note that by signing the Animal Care & Housing Form, you grant Extension Specialists permission to conduct site visits to verify the care and housing of the 4-H member's animals, provided advance notice is given.

Site visits will take place this year and going forward, so please ensure animals are properly housed and records are accurate and up to date.

Hello 4-H Families and Volunteers!

CSU and Extension have been undergoing required and necessary website accessibility changes to make Extension resources more accessible for folks who use screen-readers, need high-contrast documents or other accessible materials. This means that each County Extension Office Website will undergo these same changes.

What does this mean for our County Website?

Our El Paso County Website will be changing! It will become more accessible and hopefully more streamlined. This does mean that many of the documents, tabs and pages will be moving, changed, or updated to make them more accessible.

Animal E-Records Guidelines from Policies for Success Pg. 17 (Articles for All)

- 4-H Members must complete an E-Record book for at least one animal project area the 4-H member is enrolled in and receive a score of 70% or above.
- If the 4-H member is enrolled in multiple animal projects, they can select the project area they wish to complete a record book in. For the other animal projects, they must either exhibit them at County Fair of the current year OR write a complete 4-H story using the record book standards and receive a 70% or above to receive project completion.
- If the 4-H member is enrolled in MARKET LIVESTOCK this record book is mandatory for project completion and must receive a 70% or above.
 - EXAMPLE: If the youth is enrolled in Market Sheep and Market Goat they can pick one species (animal project area) such as Market Sheep to complete the record book on. For Market Goat they would either have to exhibit them at County Fair of the current year OR write a 4-H Story up to standards set in the record book. And receive a 70% or higher to reach project completion OR they can choose to put them in the record book.
 - EXAMPLE: If the youth is enrolled in Breeding Beef and Market Swine they would have to complete the Market Swine book. The same applies if entered in other animal projects.
- Dairy and Pygmy goats are required to be put in the breeding livestock book. There are two breeding supplement pages. One is titled Goat Doe Record supplement page which is used for breeding boar does and pygmy does. The second one is titled Breeding Goats supplement page which is used for Dairy Goats.
- Poultry Record Book
 - Will no longer use breeding supplements for any poultry projects
 - They will use the livestock record book, this includes show birds
- 4-H members are required to use the 4-H E-Record folders to qualify to go onto higher grading, which can be purchased at the El Paso County Extension Office or on the Shop 4-H Website.

Animal E-Records Guidelines from Policies for Success Pg. 17 (Articles for All)

E-Record Requirements:

- The official rubrics and score sheets should be used when grading E-Records. Rubrics and score sheets are posted in the EL Paso County Extension website on the Volunteer Resources page. If a record book is graded using the wrong rubric or does not follow outlined policies then it will not move onto further outside grading.
- Club Organizational Leaders are responsible for collecting and ensuring the following record books are graded by the deadline set by the El Paso County CSU Extension Office:
 - Animal E-Records
 - General/Tabletop/Shooting Sports E-Records that were not submitted for grading at County Fair
 - Organizational Leaders can delegate the grading of the E-Records to project leaders or other knowledgeable 4-H Volunteers.
 - Families can request guidance and grading of other knowledgeable 4-H Volunteers if following set guidelines and expectations outlines, communication with club leader is expected.
 - If a 4-H member turns in an unsatisfactory E-Record, they will be given one week to revise the E-Record to reach a score of 70% or higher. This only applies if the E-Record was turned in by the deadline set by their Club Leader. If E-Record revisions are required and completed, the 4-H member will not be eligible for end of year E-Record awards, but the satisfactory revisions will meet the completion requirement. Members that choose not to make the necessary changes to reach a score of 70% or higher will not meet the completion requirement.

4-H Project E-Records General/Tabletop/Shooting Sports E-Record Policy

E Records for Family Consumer Science, Shooting Sports, and General Projects will be turned in at the El Paso County Fair with the member's exhibit (only if the 4-H Member chooses to exhibit).

- Any Shooting Sports and/or General projects that DID NOT exhibit at the County Fair are required to be turned into the Club Leader by the Club's E-Record deadline.
 - Regarding 4-H Shooting Sports: An E-Record is required for EACH 4-H Shooting Sports Discipline in which the member is enrolled.
 - If members are enrolled in more than one discipline, they may turn in a Combined 4-H Shooting Sports E-Record by their Club Leader's deadline.

Record Book Covers

If the youth would like their record book to qualify for “higher grading” then they must submit their record book in an official 4-H record book folder. “Higher grading” refers to the process where the extension office sends out the best, qualified record books to an outside judge. The judge then places the record books, and the winners are recognized at the Achievement Awards in the fall. There are two options for purchasing, one is through the Shop 4-H website, or the Extension Office has them on hand for \$5 per folder.

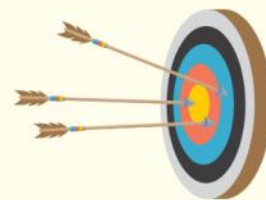

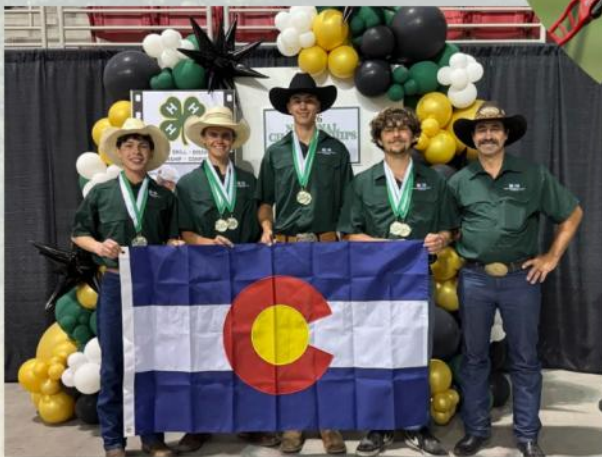

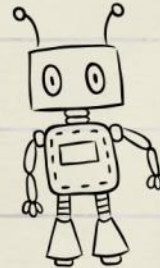

DRIVING SAFETY ON 4-H SHOOTING SPORTS RANGES

Hello 4-H Shooting Sports Folks!

As we continue with spring practices and get closer to the live-fire County Competition, this is a friendly reminder to drive **SAFELY, SLOWLY, and FOLLOW ALL SIGNAGE** on 4-H ranges.

It is very important for the safety of staff, volunteers and members that vehicles do not exceed the speed limit and pay close attention to potential hazards on dirt roads, such as washouts, berms, rough patches, and any other hazards that can cause vehicles to move dangerously.

4-H members or volunteers may be crossing the road, so be also on the look-out for people and give pedestrians the right-of-way.

It is also VERY important to adhere to parking and driving locations on the ranges. **Please do not drive offroad!**
